

## The Feast of the Lord is Going On! II

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Psalm 89:15** Blessed are the people who know **the joyful sound!** They walk, O LORD, in the light of Your countenance.

<sup>NLT</sup> **Psalm 89:15** Happy are those who hear **the joyful call to worship**, for they will walk in the light of your presence, LORD.

“Blessed – happy, fortunate (to be envied) - are the people who know the joyful sound (**who understand and appreciate the spiritual blessings symbolized by the Feasts**); they shall walk, O Lord, in the light and favor of Thy countenance”

**Psalm 89:15 Amplified**

*There are three major Feast of the Lord.*

The first feast is Passover also called **unleavened** bread.

We are to purge out all old leaven out of our lives.

Consider **Psalm 51**

We are to ask the Lord to...

1. **Wash** us 2a
2. **Cleanse** us 2b
3. **Purge** us 7a

Consider **1 Corinthians 5:8**

Natural leaven is a bit of sour dough.

Leaven **puffs** up symbolic of **pride** and **inflation**.

Leaven works **silently**, secretly and **gradually**.

The major leaven of Corinth was sensuality.

Consider **Galatians 5:9-16**

The leaven of the Galatia was **legalism**.

Legalism is a mixture of law and grace.

The Holy Spirit will give us **permission**, **prohibition** and **restraint**.

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Galatians 5:16** I say then: **Walk in the Spirit**, and you shall not fulfill the **lust of the flesh**.

<sup>NLT</sup> **Galatians 5:16** So I say, **let the Holy Spirit guide** your lives. Then you won't be doing what your **sinful nature craves**.
