

## The Feast of the Lord is Going On! III

<sup>NKJ</sup> *Psalm 89:15* Blessed are the people who know **the joyful sound!** They walk, O LORD, in the light of Your countenance.

<sup>NLT</sup> *Psalm 89:15* Happy are those who hear **the joyful call to worship**, for they will walk in the light of your presence, LORD.

“Blessed – happy, fortunate (to be envied) – are the people who know the joyful sound (**who understand and appreciate the spiritual blessings symbolized by the Feasts**); they shall walk, O Lord, in the light and favor of Thy countenance” *Psalm 89:15 Amplified*

### I

Consider *Mark 8:15* and *Mark 6:14–28*

Herod was a very **s<sup>in</sup>ful** and **w<sup>or</sup>ldly** man.

Herod feared the word in John and was not ready to repent.

He was **c<sup>on</sup>trolled** by the spirit of this world.

The leaven of Herod is **w<sup>or</sup>ldliness**.

### II

Consider *Matthew 16:6–12*

The Sadducees did not believe in the **s<sup>u</sup>pernatural**, in spirit, in angels or in the bodily resurrection. *Matthew 22:23*

The world is larger than our natural and physical existence.

The leaven of the Sadducees was **d<sup>o</sup>ctrine** and **m<sup>o</sup>dern**.

### III

Consider *Matthew 16:6–12* and *Luke 12:1*

The word Pharisee means to **s<sup>e</sup>parate**, they were **s<sup>e</sup>paratists**.

The Pharisees “say” and “do not” consider *Matthew 23:*

They were **e<sup>x</sup>ternally** clean but **i<sup>n</sup>wardly** they were rott and dead men’s bones.

The Pharisees were known for their **s<sup>e</sup>lf r<sup>i</sup>ghteousness** pride. *Matthew 23:25*

The leaven of the Pharisees is **h<sup>y</sup>ocrisy**.

Let’s purge out the old leaven worldliness, postmoderni and hypocrisy.
