The Feast of Pentecost

Deuteronomy 16:16

Three times in a year shall all thy males appear before the LORD thy God in the place which he shall choose ; in the feast of unleavened bread, and in the feast of weeks, and in the feast of tabernacles: and they shall not appear before the LORD empty:

I. Preparation for the Feast of Pentecost

Prepare - we have to know what we are getting ready for, of course it is a Feast. First, what is the definition of a feast?

A feast is defined as an elaborate and usually abundant meal, often accompanied by a ceremony.

For the kingdom, it is a periodic religious observance commemorating an event or honoring GOD.

Feasts in scripture were thought of as a mark of hospitality

Exodus 34:22

(Gen. 19:3; 2 Sam. 3:20; 2 Kings 6:23); on occasions of domestic joy (Luke 15:23; Gen. 21:8);

Normally, before you give a dinner party you must prepare. We are moving from the natural forms of preparation to the spiritual forms of preparation. Get yourself ready, clean your spiritual house.

Step One: Return to your first Love

Step Two: Forgiving those who have wronged or injured us beyond belief

Step Three: Rest, Relax, and Breathe (Exhale) again; *Leviticus 23:16-21*

II. The Covenant of Power

Giving to the Lord begins an overwhelming barrage of renewal in your life *Deuteronomy 16:10*

Whose coming... the Spirit of the Lord to rejuvenate your Spirit.

Announce that the Holy Spirit has fire reign in your life is revived.

III. Feasts of Pentecost produces the Celebration Acts 2:1-12

Remember that you were slaves in Egypt, and follow carefully these decree.

Receive the abundant Promises of the Lord (Blessings).

Restoration is nearing completion.

“who understand and appreciate the spiritual blessings symbolized by the Feasts”

Rejoice in the knowledge that you have come to the new dimension in Christ.
