

# The Feast of the Lord is Going On! “He is Lord of the Moment”

## **Psalm 89:15 (Amplified)**

Blessed (happy, fortunate, to be envied) are the people who know the joyful sound (who understand and appreciate the spiritual blessings symbolized by the Feasts): they walk, O Lord, in the light and favor of your countenance.

Let's look at some general observations of the Feasts:

### **I. The word Feast defined:**

- A.** English - “Festival”, a religious festival of rejoicing as opposed to a fast.
- B.** Hebrew - “Chagag”- to dance, indicating occasions of joy and gladness, to move in a circle, to march in a sacred procession, to be giddy
- C.** Greek - “Heorte” - It is translated : feast, holyday

*The Feasts were Celebratory Holydays! **Leviticus 23:40***

### **II. The Feasts were held three times in a year**

The Feast of Passover - 1st Month  
The Feast of Pentecost - 3<sup>rd</sup> Month  
The Feast of Tabernacles - 7<sup>th</sup> Month

- A.** Three is the number of the eternal Godhead. I John 5:7

God The Father—Creator, Sustainer, Nurturer, Producer  
God The Word—Order, Command, Revelation, Wisdom  
God The Holy Spirit—Comforter, Teacher, Convicts

*The Feasts represented the Fullness of God!*

**Colossians 2:9** – For in him dwells the fullness of the Godhead bodily.

- B.** Three is the number of a complete and perfect testimony

**Colossians 2:10** – and you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power.

**Revelation 12:11** – And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and the word of their testimony...

### **III. The Feasts originated from God**

- A.** The Feasts were on God's terms and His grounds of a approach. For this reason God set the times, place, and the sacrifices which would be involved.
- B.** The Feasts were for a redeemed, people and could only be enjoyed by being in covenantal relationship with the Lord.
- C.** In each of these Feasts God is at the heart of each moment. He is the central focus of the celebration, the gathering, and the origin.

*The Feasts represented the preeminence of God!*

The Feasts symbolize our relationship with Christ. When we realize that He is Lord of the moment and The Lord who is in the moment then:

- We can celebrate accordingly.
- We realize that unto Him shall the gathering be.
- We worship on His terms and according to His approach.

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
