II. The Testing

Just like the Silversmith's test the purity of silver, God also test the character of His people.

Bleeding up

The proper response when hurt and betrayed by people is to bleed up, go to your power source and pray directly to God.

Hannah tormented by Peninah – I Sam. 1-17 Hannah prayed to God.

Delayed prayer

When God does not respond right away it requires persistence (Luke 18:1, 11:5)

Demonic Assaults

Satan always seeks to destroy the seed (II Kings 11:1, Matt. 2:11, and Is. 59:19)

III. What does the power source consist of?
