Pernicious –satan is behind it **Job 1-2**

Puzzle – sadistic attitude **Job 3**

Punitive – punishment for sin **Job 4-31**

Purifies – pain purges shortcomings **Job 32-37**

Providentially allowed – the sovereignty of God **Job 38-42**

*NKJ* **Job 1:20**

Then Job arose, tore his robe, and shaved his head; and he fell to the ground and **worshiped**.

*NLT* **Job 1:20**

Job stood up and tore his **robe in grief**. Then he shaved his head and fell to the ground **to worship**.
